

Tel Aviv University Global Research & Training Fellowship in Medical and Life Sciences (GRTF) –  
6th Call for Applications

We announce the 6th call for travel fellowships of the Tel Aviv University Global Research & Training Fellowship in Medical and Life Sciences (GRTF) fund. The deadline for application is January 1, 2015. Applications will be made online only, in English, as described in the GRTF Guidelines file. They should be submitted by email to: [grtf@post.tau.ac.il](mailto:grtf@post.tau.ac.il). The details on GRTF fund and the application are provided in the attached GRTF Guidelines file. The applicants are requested to strictly adhere to the Guidelines when composing the proposal.

A brief reminder on GRTF goals and eligibility is provided below.

Goal/purpose: GRTF Fellowships will fund up to three months research visits of TAU young researchers, to laboratories in USA, Europe and elsewhere in the world to facilitate collaborations and to allow the visiting fellows acquire new techniques.

Eligibility: Graduate students, postdoctoral fellows, senior team members, working in research groups at the Sackler School of Medicine and the George S. Wise Faculty of Life Sciences, will be eligible for GRTFs, but not group heads (principal investigators).

Award. The maximal grant will be \$6,000 for 3 months. The recipients will be asked to provide the committee with a report of their activity at the receiving lab within 60 days after returning from the trip. The recipients are requested to use the allocated budget within 6 months after approval.

The recipient is requested to read and agree with the terms and conditions of the agreement between TAU and the Naomi Foundation (attached), and to credit the participation and support of the TAU GRTF Fund and the Naomi Foundation in any advertisement, publication resulting from the project, publicity or public comment related to the Project.
